About Test Valley Crematorium

A new crematorium serving the Borough of Romsey, Southampton, New Forest and surrounding areas has opened in Romsey. The Test Valley Crematorium is located just off Ridge Lane. It is set in a natural landscape surrounded by woodland and its opening meets the need for a new crematorium to serve the area and relieve pressure on neighbouring crematoria.

Westerleigh Group, the leading developer and operator of crematoria in the UK, was selected by the Council to build and operate a crematorium. Upon completion of the building, the firm was granted a long-term lease for the site. Finished in natural red brick, the facility provides a tranquil and convenient place for local families to hold a funeral. Test Valley promises to offer something personal and all facilities have been built to a very high standard.

The 98-seat chapel can cater for all religions and beliefs and has been fitted with large bay windows overlooking a water garden and the surrounding woodland beyond. A state of the art digital music system has been fitted alongside a traditional organ to cater for all requirements.
